



Camp Y-Koda Adventure Trip Packing List

- Change of clothes for 5 days (provide variety for weather)
- Water Bottle
- Long Pants
- Sweatshirt/jacket/fleece
- Rain Gear
- Swimsuit
- Sunglasses/hat/visor
- 1Towel
- Toiletries: Shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.
- Pillow
- Sleeping bag, or blankets to sleep with
- Flashlight
- Bug spray (lotion or pump only)
- Sunscreen
- Any medications, see additional information
- Sandals
- Closed toed shoes needed for climbing and hiking activities
- Book(s), Deck of Cards or games
- Camera (disposable preferred)
- Children can bring their own tent if they want, otherwise we will provide multi-person tents. If they want to be alone in a tent or with a specific friend, we recommend bringing their own.
- Spending money for snacks and drinks at gas stations, stores, or fast food stops along the way. Campers will be responsible to hold onto their own money if they bring any.

All meals (breakfast, lunch, dinner) and snacks are included throughout each camp day.

NO ELECTRONICS! This includes video games, music players, cell phones, and anything else they may have. Cell phones WILL BE taken away if found. If you are worried about getting in touch with your camper, we will provide you with the counselors contact information, including phone number.

WHAT NOT TO BRING: Camp strongly discourages bringing any valuables to our camp program and sleepovers. **The following items are NOT allowed at Camp Y-Koda:**
