Camp Y-Koda is located on a beautiful 80-acre parcel just west of Sheboygan Falls, WI. The property is bordered by the Sheboygan River to the north and east, has a 3-acre lake, wetlands, forests, and more than 5-acres of prairie. Camp was founded in 1969 by the Sheboygan County YMCA and has been offering camp experiences ever since.

Camp Y-Koda is best known for it's Summer Camp, Outdoor Education, Y-Koda Nature School and Nature Based Day Care. Year-round camp operates different camp experiences and environmental programs throughout Sheboygan County at locations such as the Sheboygan Marsh, Kiel Marsh, Maywood Environmental Park and beyond. Additionally, Camp offers facility rentals and High Ropes Course experiences for groups and families.

Camp has a passion for the outdoors and strongly believes in the importance of outdoor experiences for youth, families, and adults alike as an integral component of a healthy and wholesome lifestyle. If you are looking for adventure, Camp Y-Koda is it!



ON-SITE PARKING: Available for \$25 per vehicle, CASH ONLY, the day(s) of the festival.


