PART #1 - MAYWOOD MAPLE SUGAR PROGRAM

The Maywood Maple Sugar Program introduces students to the Wisconsin's annual spring tradition of "sugaring." Ever since the Native Americans discovered the flow of sweet maple sap in early spring, people have made maple syrup. Students will learn the science behind the sap, and see an old time sugaring operation in use. In addition, students will learn first hand how to tap a tree while building an understanding for proper care of our forests. Pancakes and syrup will be sent back to school.

PART #2 - LUMBERJACKS OF WISCONSIN

How did Wisconsin become the state we see today? Lumberjacks largely influenced our history. Meet one of our lumberjacks as they share life stories and show some of the tools they used to make their living. Students will spend the first part of the time in the classroom, then go outside to learn about lumberjack tools and activities. This portion is hands-on. Students are encouraged to dress like lumberjacks for this field experience.
