The High Ropes & Climbing Wall is a challenging outdoor personal development and team building activity which consists of several elements. The climbing wall requires a belay for safety. Participants climb the wall up to 40 feet up & are kept safe by using climbing harnesses, helmets, ropes and belay teams. The high elements use a Smart Belay System. The course can be physically, mentally and emotionally challenging as well as require many components of fitness including balance and coordination.

Per the YMCA Camp Y-Koda High Ropes and Challenge Course Policies; the following are limitations to participate in climbing: Participants must be at least 9 years of age and a recommended height of 55 inches tall, maximum height of 75 inches tall. Participants with a history of recent surgery, heart conditions, high blood pressure, or neck/back trouble need to have a doctor's written consent. Those who are pregnant are not permitted to climb. Weight limit of 265 lbs.

I understand that the High Ropes and Challenge Course at Camp Y-Koda requires physical actions such as: climbing, balancing, lifting and rappelling. I understand that my participation is my own choice and I, at all times, have the option to pass on an element. Climbing is inherently dangerous and participants must assume all the risks of climbing.
